Reminders:

The Board met last week to solidify some agenda items and to review some of our club practices and policies.

Here's some of what we discussed:

Social Activities:

- The Rec Center monitors all clubs' savings accounts
 - To make sure we don't have an excess
 - To strongly suggest that clubs use excess funds on member social activities
- It has been suggested that a better use of the excess money would be to purchase leather supplies and equipment.



Inventory Process:

- The initial phase of ordering & stocking supplies is complete and appears to be successful.
- We still need to establish, as a club, what should be club or individual purchases
 - Roger is the contact person
 - He is still accessing club needs & has been interfacing with Weaver
 - Concerns:
 - Supplies that are unused and dry up
 - Supplies that are used only by a few



- Placing empty containers in designated bins
- Unauthorized access to the supply cabinet
- Establishing a policy for cabinet access

Monitoring:

- In 2019 we established a 'Monitoring Committee' to review our policies. A set of new policies was created with the intention of revisiting the policies in 2020, then COVID hit.
- The Board has suggested we reestablish the 'Monitor Committee'
 - We need:
 - A chairperson & 3 to 5 volunteers
 - Purpose:
 - To review past policies
 - Solicit input from members
 - Present recommendations



Displaying Leather Items:

- The Rec Center no longer allows sales of items on the Rec Center property. For this reason, we need to establish a system that works for members without breaking the rules.
 - All tags with prices must be removed
 - A club member's name can only be displayed
 - Comments and suggestions will be solicited at the meeting

Leather Cutting:

- A discussion regarding removing leather-cutting restrictions from our current club policy will take place during the general mtg.

So, as you can see, there is a lot of very important information to discuss at the upcoming meeting on December 9th. We thought it a good idea to give you an early heads-up so you can think about these items prior to the meeting.
