The following information you may need for upcoming events affecting the Leather club. The format is a bit different than in the past. So, here goes:

- The **wallet/checkbook class** scheduled for March 22nd & 27th, 1:00 to 3:00 pm is full. If you still want to take the class, talk to Julee about being on a waiting list in case someone drops out. Cost is \$20.

- **Happy Camp:**
  - Begins next Monday, March 13th and will run the next 2 consecutive Mondays. Time is 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM. You might want to rethink the times you plan to come into the club on those days. It may be a bit crowded.
  - The tables in front of the lockers have been designated as our campsite. We thought this would keep the kids corralled and out of your hair for the most part. We have tried to minimize kid 'movement', so you should be able to get to the toolroom and machinery safely. (Good luck with your locker.)
  - BTW, we will request to have next year's Happy Camp in the afternoon. (Thought you might like that.)

- **Extended Hours:** The rec center has approved extending our hours to Monday - Friday, 8:00 AM to 8:30 PM. The club will also be open to members on Saturdays from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM. **Closed Sundays.** (Everyone needs a day of rest sometimes).

  - Due to the RHJ pool construction space for all clubs is limited. 5 tables have been designated for our use, so members will have to share what little space we have.
  - **Items for sale:** Please make sure you have completed the following requirements to sell items otherwise they can't be sold:
    - Make sure you sign your name on the **club sellers' sheet** next to an alphabet letter to help identify your sale items.
    - Fill out the '**Participant Items Form** for March 18th'.
    - Write an accurate description of each item to be sold

  - Fill out & attach a sales tag to each item.
  - Take your items along with the '**Participant Items Form** for March 18th' to the Social Hall at the designated time for our club. This form is to be given to the club cashier, Marsha.
  - If you can't take your items, see if you can find another club member to help you out.
- \*A Reminder, there may be security issues for items left overnight Friday before the opening of the fair on Saturday. This is just a risk we all take.
  - **Fair Day:** Julee & other members will be at our assigned spot in the Social Hall at 6:00 AM.
  - **Potluck:** A potluck is scheduled for March 24th. It is for all members & their guests. A signup sheet and information will be posted in the clubroom tomorrow, Friday, March 10th.
