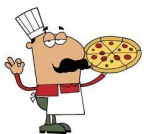
The Fall Craft Fair will be held on **November 7th, 2020.**

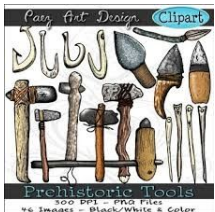

Renewals:

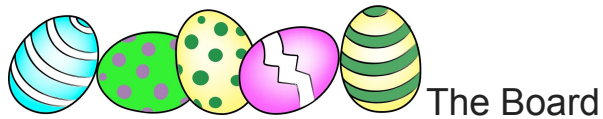
- This is just a reminder. If you are **not planning to renew** your membership this year, please let me know through an email pfischerpc@gmail.com
