Monitoring Policies for 2023 (1/13/23)

- 1. Two (2) members will be designated to record and tally yearly monitoring credits on the program 'SignUp Genius'.
- 2. It is the sole responsibility of each club member to input monitor times in the program, "SignUp Genius" sign in order to be awarded credit for his/her monitoring duty.
- 3. Members will earn credits individually not in pairs. One (1) credit per person per session.
- 4. Members in need, must petition the Board to have monitoring duties waived for a specific period of time. At the culmination of that specified time period the Board will determine the number of monitoring sessions required to fulfill the member's commitment.
 - Members with extra monitoring credits may award those credits to a member in need by contacting one of the "SignUp Genius" Admins.
 - The donating member may designate a specific member(s) or allow the admins to choose a specific member(s) to whom credits may be given.
- 5. Monitoring duties are suspended for members 85 years and over.
- 6. Monitoring duties are dropped for the four Board Officers during their tenure.
- 7. Monitoring credits will be awarded for teaching. One (1) credit for each class taught.
- 8. The monitoring requirements will be revisited each year and adjusted as membership, number of active club days, and hours decline or increase.
- 9. Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 6:00pm and Saturday 8:00 am to 4:00 pm are the days and hours for which monitoring is required.
- A monitor credit will still be awarded to a member for a minimum of two (2)hours if the club is closed prior to the end of the shift due to a lack of participating members.
- 11. If no monitor is available or willing to accept the responsibility, the club will be closed.

- A drawing will be held each year at the Christmas Dinner to award a \$25.00 'Clubs Buck' credit to four (4) members who have completed 4 monitoring duties for the year.
- 13. Monitors are required to sit at the monitoring station and wear the monitoring badge as well as his/her name tag. He/she may work on a project while working at the monitor station.
- 14. A monitor is required to monitor four (4) times from January 1st, of any year through December 31st of that same year.
- 15. Members who do not fulfill their yearly monitor duties by October 1st, will receive a written warning and have a period of three (3) months (prior to December 31st) in which to complete their duties. Non fulfillment of the monitoring requirements will result in, but is not limited to:
 - 1. Non participation in all club functions
 - 2. Non Participation in any/all sales
 - 3. Non Participation in the club stock items
 - 4. Non Participation in the use of leather club tools and equipment
 - 5. Non Participation in the use of locker privileges
 - 6. Non Participation in any and all classes
 - ii. In order to reinstate the above privileges, one must make up the previous year monitoring requirements.
- 16. Beyond this, further consequences may lead to suspension and possibly expulsion from the club as stated in the by-laws.
